Introduction

Thank you for purchasing Wishlist Protection Display!

Wishlist Protection Display adds a Protection Level column to your posts' and pages' tables, and gives you an overview of how and if your content is protected without the need to enter each post and page to check if the protection settings are correct.

Though Wishlist Protection Display sounds like a simple plugin, it is a very crucial and powerful plugin that:

1. Prevents crucial protection mistakes

Accidentally forgetting to protect content that is supposed to be protected can have devastating effect on your membership site's services and products.

Plus, you will be notified when the protection settings are not set correctly.

2. Saves you decent amount of time managing the protection settings

It allows you to easily manage your contents' protection settings in one glance, instead of having to open each post individually, just to know the protection level of each post/ page.

3. Becomes more valuable as your site grows

Especially as your membership site develops and more content is be added to it.

4. Gives you important statistic data

You get statistic information (see screenshots below) to help you see the "big picture" regarding the protected information vs. the unprotected information and use it to your own needs.

Installation

Wishlist Protection Display can be installed easily, just like any other WordPress plugin.

You can install it 2 ways:



1. Upload the folder found inside the zip file to your plugins' folder in your WordPress installation
2. Go to the plugins menu, click the "Add New" and choose the zip file you have downloaded

License Activation


To activate the plugins you purchased, you need to insert the license number.

You have 3 options to getting your licenses keys:


Click on the cart icon to go to Wishlist Member settings to manage your paid posts

Glossary

Move your mouse on top of each icon for detailed explanations or check the below glossary:

-  The Content is not protected (visible to all visitors)
-  The content is protected and pay-per-post is enabled
-  The content is protected but no protection levels were assigned. To fix the error please set your relevant levels
-  The content is protected by the displayed levels

FAQS

How do I use the plugin?

The plugin is very easy to use: After you install and activate it, you go to WL Extensions menu >> WL Protection Display >> Settings tab, set the proper setting for your website and save the changes.

Then go to Posts >> All Post or Pages >> All Pages inside WordPress menu and the Protection Level column will appear in the tables.

By hovering the mouse on each icon you will see an explanation of what the icons mean.

Does the plugin have any conflicts with other plugins?

As far as we know, the plugin does not conflict with any other plugin. Wishlist Protection Display keeps a very strict code method so the chances that it's causing any problem are very low. If you have any problems or conflicts, please try to disable the plugin and see if the problem still exists. If it does, please contact our support helpdesk.

Can the plugin be useful for me if I don't have a lot of protected content?

Yes, of course. The main purpose of the plugin is to give you an overview of how and if your content is protected and save you unfortunate mistakes.

Entering each post/ page just to check if they are protected can take a lot of valuable time.

Plus, the more content you add, the more valuable this plugin will be to you.
